GPS Address: 500 Gallaher Road, Elkton, MD **From North:** I-95 South thru DE into MD; off at exit 109A (Route 279). Route 279 toward Elkton; then right on Route 213 North to Route 273. Right onto Route 273 to Gallaher Rd; right onto Gallaher Rd then follow signs. **From South:** I-95 North to Exit 100 then Route 272 North for 5 miles to Route 273. Right on Route 273 East for 6 miles. Go thru intersection of Routes 213 and 273 passing the Fair Hill Inn. Turn right onto Gallaher Road and follow signs.

Awards: Combined Test (Dressage & Cones) – 1st to 6th/division. Teddy Bear Trot (Whimsical Country Drive) – 1st to 6th/division. Horse Trials (Dressage, Cones & Marathon) – 1st to 6th/division. **An entry may do Teddy Bear Trot OR Horse Trials but not both.**

Best Dressage; Best Teddy Bear Trot and Best Marathon for each Division; Best Young Driver; Best Conditioned

Entry Fees: \$75 for Horse Trials; \$75 for Combined Test/Teddy Bear Trot; \$60 for Combined Test Only; \$30 for Clinic (includes both topics)

BVDC Full Members get \$5 off Event and \$5 off Clinic. Associate Members pay full price.

Stabling: Only 20 stalls; at Fair Hill barns. \$40 arr Sat - Iv Sun; Extra Nights \$20. **BYOBEDDING -STRAW; NO SHAVINGS OR PAPER!**

Camping: Stabling Area ONLY; no overnights in Trailer Parking. 10 pads/Hook Up: \$40/Night **PAID by Oct 6!** Unlimited/No Hook Up: \$20/Night.

Entries: **Open September 15; Must be to Bobbi no later than October 19! Limit 25 entries – based on date of payment.** We will waitlist.

If we do not have 25 paid entries by October 19 the show will be cancelled.

Rules: Though not an ADS show, we follow ADS rules related to safety – *especially paces allowed for each level.* (see www.americandrivingsociety.org) Some turnout technicalities may be ignored; Judges are not bound by the ADS 30-day rule for instructor/student activity; Training Hazards are timed & scored. TB Trot has its own, whimsical rules.

Sharing: Only the first 5 pairs (10 entries) of sharing requests will be accommodated in the schedule. "Sharing" is a driver going twice or sharing carriage, gator, helper, etc. Equines can only go once. No 3-way sharing. Both shared entries in a pair must be PAID by the closing date to be scheduled. We will waitlist. Why: This is a fun show; complex, tight scheduling is no fun for anyone.

Age: Assumes a Jan 1 date of birth. Drivers/Navigators under 18 need signed parental consent. Drivers under 14 must be accompanied by a knowledgeable, adult horseperson. Navigators: at least 14 for Intermediate; 12 for Training/Prelim. Equines: at least 4.

Parking: Trailers park near Dressage and Cones. Drive carriage over from stabling (30min) or trailer over. Please carry out your trash!!

Times: **Times may be posted on CarriageDrivingVolunteers.org as early as 7PM Tuesday, October 30 but no later than Thursday night (11/1).**

Packets: Packets will be available from Noon, Saturday, November 3 at the Secretary's Stand.

Food: No food vendor onsite. So bring your own or chip in for the \$8 Bear Picnic Table – a variety of warm and cold picnic foods with healthy and vegetarian choices and hot tomato soup!

Vehicles: ATVs and scooters allowed for licensed drivers, wearing helmets & displaying TBP numbered permits (\$10). Golf Carts/Gators allowed without a permit. You may drive cars/trucks on the Stone Roads near hazards. Marathon/Trot are blind drives.

Water: There is NO WATER available on site, but there is water at Stabling. Bring your own water and ice (if needed).

Scoring: We have Score Bears this year, so not self-scoring is needed. Individual sheets will be available as soon as they are copied. Results will be available throughout the day. Ribbons will be available 30 minutes after scores are posted, barring protests. Best Awards will be posted late in the day. Scores will be on www.bvdc.org within 24 hours. We will mail what you don't pick up. **Score Bears Wanted!** The Bears are looking for Score Bear Volunteers! Practice scoring screens will on the TBP Home Page early October. Try out the practice screens and see if you have what it takes to be a Score Bear at the Picnic! Then sign up online or email Bobbi.

Dressage & Cones Highlights: (Please get your wheels measured **After** Dressage – in the Cones Warmup Area)

Dressage: **Training -Test 1 (40x80M) Preliminary -Test 6 (40x80M); Tandem/Team (please call) Intermediate: Test 4 (40x80M)**

We offer an extra "you pick it" test (40x80M ring) for an extra \$5. Score will not count for any class – just practice!

Cones: ADS Minimum Clearances - set for each competitor

Arena: Dressage: Stone Footing Cones: Grass Level Footing

Dress/Eq: Low key but correct: whip, gloves, hat/helmet, and apron. Driver's choice of spares - see ADS website for recommendations.

Marathon and Teddy Bear Trot Highlights:

TB Trot: **Runs After Marathon! Walk/Trot Only! Not scored like CDE:** Check your packet for the TBT Scoring Rules.

Navigator: Required for both events except for single VSE/Small Pony. Must be in 14th year (12th Tr/Pre). Able to provide quick, reliable help.

Course: Rolling terrain, wooden bridge & maybe mud! **Horse/Pony** - No more than 5K; **VSE** - No more than 3K; ADS Speeds

Course Walk: No course walk. Both Trot and Marathon are to be driven blind. You may inspect hazards and some of the tasks.

Rule Notes: **Helmets required for BOTH Driver and Navigator for Trot and Marathon.** Juniors must wear helmets and vests while on a carriage anywhere on the grounds. Driver must carry a whip in hand while on course. Spares as required by Driver. **Pace rules will be strictly enforced for the safety of all!** Training Hazards will be scored! Teddy Bear Trot Task List will be in your packet.
