

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The consumption or possession of an open container of an alcoholic beverage will be prohibited in all Maryland State Park areas including campgrounds with the exception of the areas designated by the park manager. Groups reserving areas where alcohol is permitted are required to purchase an Alcohol Permit. Alcohol Permits are issued by the park office and cost \$35. Additionally, groups who plan to sell alcoholic beverages are required to obtain a Temporary Liquor License from the Cecil County Liquor Board.

All Maryland State Parks are Trash Free. All visitors must make necessary arrangements to remove trash after event or visit and remember to sort all recyclable materials. Large events must independently contract for trash removal as part of their event coordination.

Event planners are asked to make a genuine effort to help us keep our restrooms clean and operational. Additionally, keeping unnecessary lights off and conserving water will pay great dividends in keeping future costs and service charges down.

EQUESTRIAN CAMPING RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. By Maryland State Regulation, attendees are required to carry evidence of a negative Coggins test, current within twelve months.
2. Check-in/Check-out time for Race Barn Stalls and Camp Pads is 3:00 pm.
3. Equestrian users are required to use STRAW ONLY for bedding. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL CHIPS OR PAPER BE USED. All straw used in stalls must be removed and placed in area designated by a blue colored sign, "STRAW ONLY".
4. All stalls are to be cleaned and swept. Nametags and appurtenances must be removed prior to user departure. For stalls not properly cleaned, the user will be charged a cleaning fee of \$25. Corralling is not permitted.
5. Campfires are permitted at the designated Equestrian Camp Pads, inside the fire rings or outside the Race Barn perimeter driveway **ONLY!** If the campfire is not in a fire ring on a designated Camp Pad, it must be contained in a raised fire bowl. No fires will be permitted directly on the ground. All firewood must be purchased from the firewood rack located at the Race Barns for \$5 per bundle due to outbreaks of two insects, the Emerald Ash Borer and the Walnut Twig Beetle. **Firewood cannot be brought into Fair Hill from outside sources.**
6. Lights, light fixtures and panel boxes are not to be altered or tampered with. In addition, plugging camping units into buildings at Race Barns area is not permitted.
7. Washing of vehicles and trailers is prohibited.
8. Any wood or rock for chocking or leveling trailers or vehicles is to be removed.
9. No vehicles or trailers are to be parked on roadways, as they also serve as FIRE LANES and AVENUES FOR EMERGENCY VEHICLES.
10. It is the responsibility of each Event Planner to tailor and prepare dressage rings for their use.
11. All users are to stay on designated trails in the hayfields during the hay growing and harvesting season.
12. **SMOKING IS PROHIBITED** in all buildings to include stalls and barns.
