

Teddy Bear Trot Overview

Some Bears have sneaked off to private picnic spots and the Rangers don't have time to look for them and check that the Bears are following the rules. Your job is to spot their picnic spots and report them to the Watch Bear at the End of Trot. You will get points for every Bear Spot you spot if you can say the Activity posted on the sign at the spot.

You can choose 3K or 6K route. You do not have to decide before you go. The person at Trot End will ask which route you took.

If you signed up for Drive, but decide to spot bears, just tell the guy at the end which ones you spotted and we will switch you to Point to Point – for ribbons.

There are more bears on the 6K than the 3K route but we will handle that difference in the scoring formula. So you can win whichever route you take.

You have a target time, Time Allowed, and you are allowed to be 5 minutes over or under that time before you start getting penalty points. Please don't hog the trail by dilly-dallying!

This is a game not a serious competition, so have fun imagining all the happy, hiding bears at play!
