

Super Reinsmanship Scribe – Pleasure

Before the Class:

- Get instructions from your Judge about how to fill out the individual scoresheet (judge's card) for each competitor.
- Get instructions from your Judge on how to calculate Total Score for each competitor.
- Get agreement on when to record the individual scores on the Judge's Card for the class.
- Get agreement on who will do the calculation. It may be the Judge, or you may have a Ring Scorer or you may have to do it yourself.

Tasks for Each Competitor in the Class:

1. Write the Competitor Number and a brief description of the entry – in case we need to figure out who this really was, later. Don't assume! Have "eyes on" the number before you write it!
2. For each element of the test, the Judge will tell you the score and a comment. Be sure to keep up and not miss any movements. Half points are allowed so be sure to write clearly.
3. Record the Driver General Impression score and comment.
4. Record the Overall Impression score and comment.
5. Record any Penalties and the reason – they get SUBTRACTED so put them in ().
6. Calculate the Total Score
7. Record an E, R, W or D in the "Total" box if necessary and note the reason.
8. Get the Judge to sign the card. If permitted, record the score on the Judge's Card for the class.

Tasks at the End of Each Class

9. Have the Judge "Place" the Class.
10. If you have not already done so, fill out the Judges Card for the class. Be sure to include every competitor. Enter zero for successful but not placed. Enter E, R, W, or D for those who did not successfully complete the class.
11. Have the Judge to sign the Class Judges Card.
12. Give the individual scoresheets and Class Judge's Card to the ScoreRunner.
